Standard Room - The standard room rate is \$199.00 for 1-2 people per room per night plus an Historical Preservation Fund (HPF) fee of \$12.94, occupancy tax of \$5.97, and sales tax of \$12.72. An additional \$40 per person per night (plus applicable HPF fee and taxes) will apply to each third or fourth adult occupant in the room.

Other Accommodations - Due to the historic nature of the Greenbrier, room types vary in size and locations. Please be very specific about the number of guests staying in your room and any other specific room requests at time of booking. Requests for specific guest rooms or deluxe accommodations can be made by adding the following amounts to the nightly run-of-house room rates based on availability.

- *Intermediate Rooms - additional \$50.00 per bedroom, per night*
- *Superior Room - additional \$100.00 per bedroom, per night*
- *Junior Suite - additional \$150.00 per bedroom, per night*
- *Spring Row Cottages - additional \$190.00 per bedroom, per night*

Roll-away beds are available at no charge but are restricted to specific room types. Be sure to reserve your roll-away at time of booking.

Daily Resort Fee Waived - The daily resort fee is waived for NEAFCS and includes access to a number of amenities including WiFi in the guest rooms and public spaces.

Hotel Confirmation/Cancellation Policy: Individual reservations may be made by credit card or deposit of the first night's room and tax. Cancellations will be refunded outside of 14 days prior to arrival. Please see your reservation confirmation or speak with the reservationist about cancellation policy.

No smoking- All rooms and public spaces are non-smoking.



Dress Code - The Greenbrier adheres to a strict dress code across the resort and in all dining facilities. In general; no tank tops, cut-offs, short-shorts, sweatpants, wind pants, torn or ripped denim, robes, swimwear, men's hats or baseball caps are permitted in public areas (outside of your guest room). The majority of the resort adheres to a resort attire dress code with evenings and dining rooms requiring more formal attire.

Weather in West Virginia in November historically has been High 77, Low 26, and Average 51. Please keep in mind The Greenbrier Resort spans more than 10,000 acres, so you may need to travel outside during your stay.
