Zion National Park Follow the paths where ancient native people and pioneers walked. Gaze up at massive sandstone cliffs of cream, pink, and red that soar into a brilliant blue sky. Absorb the rich history of the past and enjoy the excitement of present day adventures.





Brian Head Peak and Cedar Breaks
Hike up to the top of Brian Head Peak 11,300 feet
above sea level (actually you drive to about
11,290 feet and then you hike 50 yards and gain
the remaining 10 feet elevation). Investigate the
high altitude and view the awesome scenery.

Stay Here <u>Panguitch, Utah</u>

Home to some of the most majestic scenery on earth. A Native American Paiute word meaning "Big Fish," and is undoubtedly named for the famously plentiful lakes in the nearby mountains.

DAYTWO

Bryce Canyon National Park Stop at Bryce Canyon where Ebenezer Bryce exclaimed, "It's a hellava place to lose a cow!"Hoodoos exist on every continent, but here is the largest concentration found anywhere on Earth. Situated along a high plateau, the park's high elevations include fantastic dark skies and geological wonders that defy description.





Lower Calf Creek Hike (6 Mile Hike Round Trip) 130-foot waterfall oasis surrounded by amazing Navajo Sandstone, this place is a must see. Though mostly level, the trail frequently crosses vast sandy tracts that can make it difficult for some to navigate. See two prehistoric Fremont peoples' granaries and a group of pictograph panels, dated to approximately AD 1200.

America's Scenic Highway 12 You'll be able to drive along what is locally referred to as the Hogsback this is where the canyons drop 1,000 feet on both sides of the highway.

Capital Reef National Park A rich cultural history dating to archaic hunter-gatherers, the prehistoric Fremont Culture, and pioneer homesteaders. Observe Utah pioneer heritage, and their self-reliance and sustainability. Be sure to pick fresh fruit for the orchards!

Stay Here
Torrey, Utah

Torrey is an idyllic little tree-lined town on the Capitol Reef Country Scenic Byway (S.R. 24) surrounded by rose-colored cliffs and green meadows



Leave for Snowbird and travel through Rural Utah on Heritage Highway 89 for the most scenic route! *Approximately 4 hours from Capital Reef
