- Established "President's Meeting": Immediate Past President, President-Elect, and President met in regularly to plan and prepare for activities. This was a great opportunity for mentoring and to maintain continuity among leaders and goals for the affiliate.

  - Hosted Coffee Break event/send off for members attending JCEP ELC. Invited ESP, NACAA, and NAE4-HYDP members attending conference – 9 attended coffee break, representing NEAFCS, ESP, NAE4-HYDP

- Spring Social Event
