 one year of NEAFCS state level membership for any new hire to lowa's field staff position. We also were able to
 utilized the scholarship this year with our first recipient being Hailey Burgher!
- Hosted an affiliate book study for on The Secret History of Home Economics by Danielle Dreilinger. We had 21
 participants, including two life members, two lowa staff who are not members of NEAFCS, and 17 active
 members. All participating active members were eligible to receive a copy of book, paid for by the state affiliate.
